

SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE

Lanyards

All members of the Sixth Form are required to wear a lanyard at all times whilst in school as part of the dress code.

House Badges

All members of the Sixth Form are required to wear their House badge.

Suits

Students must wear a formal, tailored suit including blazers/jackets and trousers, skirts or dresses. Suits should be black, navy or dark grey in colour. Blazers/jackets must be worn at all times but can be taken off in lessons.

Tops

Short or long-sleeved smart tops, blouses, or a shirt must be worn. Tops must meet the waistband of the trouser/skirt being worn and the sleeve must cover the whole shoulder.

Ties

A school tie must be worn with shirts.

Skirts and dresses

Skirts and dresses must be black, navy or dark grey and be no shorter than mid-thigh length. Stretchy/bodycon skirts/dresses are not permitted. Tights must be worn.

Trousers

Trousers must be black, navy or dark grey, of a tailored/suit style. Leggings and denim trousers cannot be worn.

Footwear

Footwear should be sensible for a working environment. Trainers, boots, stiletto heels and canvas shoes are not permitted.

Coats and Outdoor wear

Coats must be black, navy or dark grey and should be removed once inside the buildings.

Hats should be removed inside the building

Other

- Leggings, ' jeggings ', jeans or jeans style/material, 'skinny-fit' trousers, 'bodycon' skirts, sportswear and hoodies are not permitted
- Trainers, boots, stiletto heels and canvas shoes are not permitted.
- Body piercing except ear piercing is not allowed.
- Hair must be of a natural colour.
